

EAR/IOM Helps to Provide Fresh Water for the Serbian Village of Korminjane/Korminjan

On 14 November 2006, the first glasses of drinking water were taken from the newly constructed water system to commemorate the successful conclusion of the project in the village Korminjane/Korminjan in Kamenicë/a municipality. In cooperation with Mercy Corps, Kamenicë/a Municipality and the village of Korminjane/Korminjan, the EAR/IOM Community Stabilisation Programme (CSP) supported the community's effort in completing the ongoing construction of the water system. Mr. Enrico Ponziani, Chief of Mission (CoM) of IOM Kosovo, Ms. Tina Kaidanow, CoM of the US Office in Pristina (USOP), Mr. Miodrag Mojsic, village leader and Mr. Shaip Shurdulli, municipal president, jointly inaugurated the project. The construction of two pump stations and a power supply unit was provided by the EAR/IOM CSP programme through a local contractor. In this way, the 1,570 resident of this village were ensured a source of reliable drinking water.
